5.1 ASCE Grant:

- \$500 grant available
- Tentative Date Chosen: December 1 (evening)

Action: Three options looking into cost/availability, for Parent engagement event. Planning put to committee, as it needs to happen before next meeting.

5.2 Score Clock:

- Request needs to be submitted to STAR Secretary Treasurer (prior to proceeding with any funding requests)
- CIP Grant needs to be submitted by January 15 (we'll know if funding is granted by July 15)
- Knights of Columbus Funding letter to be drafted
- School Funding letter to be drafted

Action: put to committee, to determine if we will proceed this year.

5.3 Bring Your Own Device:

- Parents still concerned about theft, and inquired about locks.
 - Notre Dame doesn't have locks, and Fr. Leduc only does for Jr. High.
 - Parents still concerned about other things also getting stolen (shoes, etc). Reminder that reporting is critical.



- Possible solutions to concerns, if locks not possible:
 - Only using STAR Catholic internet (with restrictions)
 - Teaching technology safety
 - Utilizing security cameras (when reported)
 - Minimize personal items at school
 - Admin introduced outdoor bags for recess, to reduce personal items at school for recess purposes
 - Students can request specific sports, etc.

5.4 Home Safe/Babysitting Courses

- Keep private unless spots need filling (insurance changes)
- My Safe (Gr. 2-3) 6 hrs (split into 3hr days?)
- Home Alone (Gr. 4-5) 6.5 hrs (split into 3hr days?)
- Babysitting (Gr 6, 12 years old) 8 hrs (full day)
 - Each course is \$68.25 per student, user pay
 - Minimum 8 students per class
 - Maximum 25 students per class (3 free spots)
 - Every 9 registrations gives us one free
 - Paying the 10% admin fee, for program organization/registration
- Teddy Bear First Aid (K & Gr. 1)
 - Build into a school day (30-60 min program)
 - Cover with kickback (\$125/hr)
- Utilizing PD Days/After School hours:
 - Home Alone & Babysitting: Feb 8/9, Possibly April?
 - Possibly Jan 8, 15 & 22 for My Safe Life (pending confirmation)

Action: Committing to programs, booking learning common, confirming space with after school care.

6.1.7 Lunch Times:



- Eating time begins when the bell rings, even though once the bell rings, they have to come all the way in from outside, shed outdoor gear, get to their classrooms and eat, in 15 minutes.
- Div 1 doesn't seem to have problem, teachers are able to accommodate when students are hungry.
- Div 2's time seems more limited, as it presents more of a challenge to allow eating during instructional time.

Action: Admin to take concerns to staff about eating accommodations, timing, and nutrition concerns.

6.1.8 Open Gym Dates:

- Looking at accommodating 1 per month or bi-weekly
- Family participation only, no child unattended
- Theme to each one (sport or activity specified in advance)
- Discussion of using a google form or sign up genius, or just having it open, with a first come first served policy (for capacity reasons)
- Probably coordinating January-May

Action: Discussion, before being tabled until November meeting.

6.1.9 School Lock Policy:

- Parents are concerned about the front doors being unlocked during the day.
- Admin took concern to the superintendent, as Alberta Education doesn't manage the policy, it's on a board level.
- Parents were reminded of the correct processes of advocating for change.
- New doorbell has potential for video & voice
- Need to ensure doorbell is active (particularly for afterschool care, when the doors must be locked (different governing body)
- Practicing drills
 - Hold & Secure: locked in, but allowed to roam
 - o Lockdown: quiet, still, hidden

Action: Admin investigating further.
